2016 Scholarship Awards - Each year the Executive Council of Upsilon Pi Epsilon evaluates a large number of scholarship applications from students at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. All scholarship applicants are required to complete a comprehensive application form including a statement on their long-term plans for the profession, a summary of their contributions to their respective UPE chapters and related student activities at their college or university. Applicants are also required to submit all college-level transcripts and a recommendation from the UPE faculty adviser. Council is pleased to present our list of Scholarship Awards for 2016.

UPE Named Scholarship Awards – These awards are named in honor of two UPE pioneers. Dr. Dan Drew was the principal adviser to the six CS students who are credited with the founding of UPE at Texas A&M University in 1967. Dr. Jim Nolen started the UPE chapter at Baylor University and was a significant contributor to student-related activities of the ACM.

New UPE Award in 2017 – The UPE Executive Council will be adding a new award category, the ***UPE Outstanding Achievement Award***, for student members of UPE. There will be one award each year with an award amount that will be at least \$500 higher than the *Named Scholarship Awards* (or \$3,000 for 2017). Candidates for this award will be chosen from the pool of UPE Scholarship applicants for 2017. For this award, Council will carry out much greater scrutiny on the student's academic achievements as well as her/his participation, contribution and accomplishments outside the classroom (while in pursuit of the undergraduate or graduate degree in the computing and information discipline).

UPE eBook to Commemorate the 50th Anniversary of UPE - In 2017, UPE will celebrate its 50th anniversary since its establishment at Texas A&M University in 1967. In honor of this historic event, the UPE Executive Council, through the efforts of the ***UPE Chapter at DePaul University***, is in the process of creating an *eBook* about the most memorable activities of the Executive Council as well as past and present activities of the Chapters of UPE. *This eBook will be distributed to all UPE members in January 2017.*

Outstanding Chapter Awards – UPE will continue to present cash awards to outstanding UPE chapters in the coming year. Details on UPE award to chapters will be announced in December 2016.

ICPC Awards – During the 2016 ICPC World Finals in Phuket, Thailand, UPE presented cash awards to programming teams who were judged to be the “first solvers” of problems posed at the ICPC. Similar awards will be presented by UPE at the 2017 ICPC World Finals in Rapid City, South Dakota.
